SAN DIEGO — Ed Chapuis, an experienced newsroom leader, is the new news director for KGTV 10News, effective Sept. 25. Chapuis is coming to KGTV, the ABC affiliate owned by the E.W. Scripps Company, from KTXL in Sacramento, California, where he has been the vice president and news director since 2013. He's credited with building the Fox affiliate's reputation in the market. He also has 15 years of leading legacy newsrooms in San Francisco and Sacramento.
