Reed joined Griffin Communications as News Director for News 9 in March 1995. Three weeks later Oklahoma City was rocked by the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building. "Joyce guided our newsroom through two of the darkest days ever seen in Oklahoma – the Oklahoma City Bombing and the May 3, 1999 tornado outbreak," said Rob Krier, Griffin Communications Chief Operating Officer. "Joyce is a trailblazer who has left an undeniable mark on Griffin and the State of Oklahoma. Her wisdom, passion and strategic thinking are a large part of why our stations are number one."

After Reed's time in the News 9 newsroom she moved into a corporate role focusing on business development. She then became Vice President of Content in 2009 responsible for leading Oklahoma's largest TV news team.
