

TINA LUQUE NAMED VICE PRESIDENT AND NEWS DIRECTOR OF FOX DUOPOLY IN CHARLOTTE

CHARLOTTE – Tina Luque has been named Vice President and News Director of the FOX duopoly in Charlotte, which consists of WJZY FOX 46 and WMYT My12, announced station Vice President and General Manager, Kieran Clarke. Effective April 12, 2016, Luque will oversee all editorial, business, and administrative functions for WJZY/WMYT News, reporting directly to Clarke.

Clarke added, “I am very excited for Tina to join us as the leader of the WJZY newsroom. Tina’s leadership, team building, and news brand development skills will be a tremendous asset to Fox46 as we continue to build upon our quality news product.”

Most recently, Luque served as News Director for WTKR/WGNT in Norfolk/Virginia Beach, VA. Previously, she spent five years as News Director for WIS in Columbia, SC. Prior to that, Luque was Assistant News Director for WHDH in Boston. Before that, she held the roles of executive producer at WCAU in Philadelphia, producer at WTAE in Pittsburgh, and executive producer at WCSC in Charleston, SC.

A graduate of Pennsylvania State University, Luque holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Broadcast Journalism.

Luque added, “I am excited to work at a station that carries The Carolina Panthers NFC games and is the home of groundbreaking investigative journalism. Recently, FOX 46 broke multiple stories about abuse, forcing people to be held accountable for their actions and resulting in justice. That is the kind of journalism our viewers will come to rely on from FOX 46 Charlotte.”

WJZY/WMYT is part of the FOX Television Stations, one of the nation's largest owned-and-operated network broadcast groups, comprising 28 stations in 17 markets and covering over 37% of U.S. television homes. This includes seven duopolies in the top 10 markets: New York, Los Angeles, Chicago, Dallas, San Francisco, Washington, D.C. and Houston; as well as duopolies in Minneapolis, Phoenix, Orlando and Charlotte.
